
ASK RECYCLE COACH



Oro Loma keep the water in the Bay clean.

Wastewater collection and treatment is what we do at Oro Loma. We collect used water from homes - toilets, sinks, showers, and washing machines – through 272 miles of sewer pipeline that moves it to our treatment plant in San Lorenzo. We treat the water to remove impurities and return it to the San Francisco Bay.
