- Receive collection reminders and real-time updates.







### WM Curbside Holiday Tree Pickup



**January 2 - 12, 2024** 

- Natural trees only, 6 ft and under, or trees cut into lengths smaller than 6 ft.
- NO flocking, tinsel, ornaments, tree stands, or nails. (Cut up flocked trees and place in the trash.)
- Place natural trees next to your green organics cart on your regular collection day.
- After January 12, 2024, natural trees may be cut up and placed in the green cart for pickup.
- Bulky waste pickup is suspended during the holiday tree pickup period.
