**Summary of
ORDINANCE NO. 34-42**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL
AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE AND OTHER DISCARDED MATERIALS**

At the regular meeting of the Sanitary Board of Oro Loma Sanitary District held August 15, 2017, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 34-42, which regulates the collection, removal and disposal of refuse and other discarded materials within the District. This Ordinance replaces the previous version of Ordinance 34.

In accordance with the January 1, 2012 Oro Loma/Waste Management Agreement for Services, rates are contractually adjusted every year by a combination factor based on the April-April CPI-U and the weighted average of teamsters wage, benefits and pension contract annual increases.

Effective September 1, 2017, residential, multi-family and commercial refuse, and commercial recycling and green waste charges will increase by 3.79%. Charges collected on the tax roll for residential recycling and green waste will remain unchanged.
