**Summary of  
ORDINANCE NO. 34-43**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL,  
AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE AND OTHER DISCARDED MATERIALS**

At the regular meeting of the Sanitary Board of Oro Loma Sanitary District held August 21, 2018, the Board adopted Ordinance No. 34-43, which regulates the collection, removal and disposal of refuse and other discarded materials within the District. This Ordinance replaces the previous version of Ordinance 34.

In accordance with the January 1, 2012 Oro Loma/Waste Management Agreement for Services, rates are contractually adjusted every year by a combination factor based on the April-April CPI-U and the weighted average of teamsters wage, benefits and pension contract annual increases.

**Effective September 1, 2018, residential, multi-family and commercial refuse, and commercial recycling and green waste charges will increase by 2.91%.**

In addition, the following amendments were made to the Ordinance, also effective September 1, 2018:

**Definitions, 1.33**

The term “monthly late charge” means the 2.0% fee imposed on residential refuse accounts that become 90 days delinquent and on commercial refuse accounts that become 30 days delinquent.

**Rates for Service, 6.2**

If the invoice is not paid in full, the Designated Collector is authorized to impose a 2.0% monthly late charge on residential refuse accounts that become 90 days delinquent and on commercial refuse accounts that become 30 days delinquent. The Designated Collector shall also send to the Owner of record written notification of the Owner’s responsibility for payment for such services and the District’s authority to collect said amount(s) on the tax roll.
